  - Education and Skill Development
  - Community Organization
  - Public and Organizational Policy
  - Professional Growth and Responsibility
- To demonstrate the nominee's qualifications as a candidate for the Problem Gambling Prevention Practitioner of the Year, nominators must identify those qualities or characteristics that make their nominee unique and provide specific examples of work behavior or accomplishments which they believe reflect exceptional performance. ***Please avoid global characterizations.***
- Self and co-worker nominations are acceptable.
